

## **BOAT / EQUIPMENT USE ON SITE AND AWAY ON HOLIDAYS**

## **USING CLUB BOATS and equipment.**

- Any and every time you use any of the Club's boats and/or equipment it is ENTIRELY your responsibility
  - (1) to ascertain the general condition of the boat (eg rudder working properly, observable hull damage, does it have sufficient buoyancy; will the flotation come loose & float away in a capsize? etc.;; and to NOT use the craft/equipment if you identify any defects.
  - (2) to maintain the boat/ whilst in your possession in a proper condition for your activity and
  - (3) to determine that this boat is suited to your needs, skills and environment.
  - (4) This also applies to any other club equipment you use, e.g. pfd (do the clips work properly; is there any damage to the jacket, eg rips) or paddle.
  - (5) If the boat is in your possession, it is assumed
    - (a) that you followed the stipulations above;
    - (b) you are therefore responsible for any damage or loss sustained to the boat or other club equipment when it is returned to the club.

## Procedure for taking a boat away from the club for personal use.

Apart from using the Club's boats every time you paddle at the club, as a member you can also periodically take a Club boat away with you for short periods – **up to a week**. When you wish to do this it is vital that you follow these steps –

- 1. Ensure you have checked **the black-board Inside the boat shed** at least 3-4 days prior to removing the boat from the club precinct to ensure the boat **is not required by the club for use in one of its many organised programs or pre-booked by another member for the same date/s.** If it is prebooked select another boat. If the boat of choice is available then -
- YOU MUST advise the club by email wynnumcc@yahoo.com of your desire to borrow the intended boat, including the dates and approx. collection and return times. Providing the 'away' period is for no more than 7 days, no objection will be raised.
- 3. If you would like to have the boat away for an extended period you must specifically request it. It will be considered by the Committee and may be granted.
- On the blackboard, enter
  - (a) Your Name and **clear-to-read** Phone number;
  - (b) The Boat Number &/or other description;
  - (c) The dates you will be collecting and returning the boat.
- 5. Donate \$5 per boat per day you have the boat(s) including pick-up and return date;

- 6. When you have returned the boat, REMOVE your details from the blackboard.
- 7. Club Craft and equipment must be returned in good order or the user is responsible for the costs of repairs or replacement.
- 8. Payment is TO BE MADE PROMPTLY; EITHER INTO THE METAL BOX at the club, marked with the member's name to identify the purpose or into the club's bank account suitably tagged. Wynnum Redlands Canoe Club Inc. Bank of Qld; BSB 124 012; Account No. 11147923.
- 9. Once the Committee has approved your proposal, the Shed Managers will be notified and if possible, will assist in facilitating the collection and return of your craft.

BE AWARE YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL DAMAGE THAT OCCURS TO ANY CLUB EQUIPMENT AT ALL TIMES WHILST IT IS IN YOUR CARE &/or use.

This may include cost of repairs or replacement.
